Class Information

Participants in all classes will be instructed on full swing technique, short game skills and scoring, as well as proper etiquette in and around the clubhouse and range. Participants may also be introduced to exercises specific to golf and their benefit to the muscle coordination needed to play well.

All programs will require clubs for the short game and full swing. Having the right clubs for your child is important for learning the proper technique. We recommend a set of clubs specifically matched for each participant. We have US Kids sets available for younger golfers and encourage you to purchase any equipment well in advance of our program.

***Note** – All classes will follow the same curriculum but each student will receive individual instruction relating to their needs. Participants may be experienced or at the beginner level but will be instructed in a manner that they can understand and incorporate immediately. All of my instruction is results oriented and we want your children to get the most out of their time with us.

Age or experience for participation – Please know that I do not accept juniors who have not completed the 1st grade. I want all juniors to experience golf at a young age but the classes require participants to be able to write their name in a specific place on a golf scorecard, count the number of strokes for each player, fill in the appropriate number when keeping score and display good sportsmanship. Without these skills, we cannot move the class along consistently.

As a parent, I understand how children are vastly different when based on age. For this reason, my programs mirror the school system and does not blend 2nd graders with 9th graders. Each Masters group has a specific time and day for their program. I appreciate your understanding and look forward to working with you children.

Lunch is provided each day and the participants may choose one item from a menu consisting of a grilled cheese sandwich, hot dog, sausage dog or chicken fingers. Chips or fries and a drink is also included.

Early Arrival:

Arriving early each day is important to having our program start on time. Check in is 15 minutes in advance of our designated start time. Classes will meet at our Golf Academy and instruction is performed from the Academy and teaching area on the back of the range. The back teaching area is located on the far side of our practice range so parents may be required to deliver their children to this area if they are arriving late. From the club house, turn right on Pine Lakes Blvd, turn right on Eagle Bend, turn right on Pine Lake Crossing and finally, turn right on Stone Trail. You should be able to see the practice range and the gathering of kids on the other side of the pond.

Attire:

All participants will receive a WindRose hat, hat clip ball marker and divot repair tool for their attendance in our programs. Like adults, Boy Junior Masters must wear a shirt with a collar and cut off shorts are not allowed. Girl Junior Masters may wear a shirt without a collar but must not be a T shirt.



Please include sunscreen, bottle water and light snacks for your children. Having sun protection and water are vital. The snack should consist of granola bars or fruit bars. Please avoid candy bars or heavy sweets.
